## Allen's policy on course retakes?

(If a student fails a course and wants to retake it, how does it affect the student's GPA and how does it appear on their transcript?)

Retakes appears as an "R" next to the repeated course. Student are allowed up to three (3) opportunities to repeat a course.

The last attempt counts towards the GPA.

Allen University also allows students who receive an "I" to take the course the next term and replace the "I" on their transcript with a new grade.
